

TOWN OF PORTERFIELD
Monthly Town Board Meeting

Wednesday, February 10, 2021

Chairperson Dennis Bergeson called the monthly meeting to order at 6:00 PM with 12 in attendance.

Don Limberg made a motion to accept the agenda as listed. Audrey Guseck seconded the motion. Roll Call: Audrey Guseck – yes, Don Limberg – yes, Dennis Bergeson - yes. Agenda approved.

Audrey Guseck made a motion to approve the past minutes as read. Don Limberg seconded the motion. Roll Call: Audrey Guseck – yes, Don Limberg – yes, Dennis Bergeson – yes. Minutes approved.

Wendell Philipps gave the treasurer's report noting the total cash on hand as of January 29, 2021 was \$580,706.69. Don Limberg made a motion to approve the treasurer's report as read. Audrey Guseck made a motion to take \$51,996.59 out of the Property Tax Account into the Reserve MM Acct. Don Limberg seconded the motion. Roll Call: Audrey Guseck – yes, Don Limberg – yes, Dennis Bergeson – yes. Motion approved.

During Open Floor – Note: Town residents can pay property taxes online instead of going to the Courthouse through the Marinette County Website. There was a sale of some town equipment – Forklift sold for \$860 + fees and the bucket for \$1400 and the forks for \$480. The equipment was from the skid steer and was put on Wisconsin Surplus Auction. Thanks went out to Ken Brissette for helping list the items online.

Reminder to vote on Tuesday, February 16, 2021 for the Primary Election.

There were no operator license applications this month.

Roads – Thanks was given out to the Plow drivers for doing a great job.

Fire Commission – Ken Brissette stated there were 8 calls since our last meeting consisting of 4 vehicle assists, 1 lift assist, 1 chimney fire, 1 tree on wire and 1 MABAS assist for the Town of Lake fire.

Building Permits - a report from Wayne Ruechel was read including 59 permits for 2020 in which buildings made up 45 with an approximate value of \$1,593,840.00 and 13 electrical with an approximate value of \$46,800.00, and 1 miscellaneous of \$10.00. Supervisor, Audrey Guseck noted there were 5 new homes built in 2020 and already one this year.

Correspondence was read and bills were paid.
