**Monthly Town Board Meeting**

Wednesday, August 11, 2021

Chairperson Dennis Bergeson called the monthly meeting to order at 6:00 PM with 15 in attendance.

Don Limberg made a motion to accept the agenda as listed. Audrey Guseck seconded the motion. Roll Call: Audrey Guseck – yes, Don Limberg – yes, Dennis Bergeson - yes. Agenda approved.

Audrey Guseck made a motion to approve the past minutes as read. Don Limberg seconded the motion. Roll Call: Audrey Guseck – yes, Don Limberg – yes, Dennis Bergeson – yes. Minutes approved.

Wendell Philipps gave the treasurer's report noting the total cash on hand as of July 30, 2021 was \$450,458.69. Don Limberg made a motion to approve the treasurer's report as read. There were no operator licenses to approve this month.

Roads – 4 culverts were put into Winesville Rd. South end of Bagley has been fine graded and compacted and ready to be paved as soon as weather cooperates which is the same for Panske Road. The north end of Bagley was chip-sealed by the County to prevent deterioration. Future projects will depend on finances.

Fire Commission – no one from the commission was present at this meeting.

Cemetery Committee – Thanks went out to Panske Trim-A-Tree for a job well done taking down the Spruce Tree and cleaning the area.

Recycling – Running smoothly.

Building Permits – We have one rebuild that was burnt and a cabin going up.

Correspondence was read and bills were paid. There was discussion on No Wake Signs on the Menominee River near Schroeder Road.
