What can be recycled in the recycling building?

1) Glass - all color and sizes 2) Plastic - all type 3) Cardboard 4) Newspaper Magazines and Catalogs

Leaves/Brush: Go on the compost pile.

Oil: No charge

Anti-Freeze: Not accepted!!

Fluorescent Lamps: Not accepted

TV'S: \$10 and up depending on size

Refrigerators: \$10 (Freon needs to be removed) DOORS MUST BE REMOVED

Freezers: \$10 (Freon needs to be removed) DOORS MUST BE REMOVED

Air Conditioners: \$10 (Freon needs to be removed)

Dehumidifiers: \$10 (Freon needs to be removed)

Hoses and Tarps: All hoses and tarps go into the dumpster and get charged accordingly.

Tires: depending on the size - starting at small tires \$4 up

Iron/Steel/Copper/Tin/Sheet Metal/Aluminum: Iron and steel things can be put on the steel pile which is hauled away at no cost to Town of Porterfield residents.

Bags of Garbage that cannot be recycled: Cost per bag is \$2 (\$3 if extra-large bag)
